

DASHWOOD SAUVIGNON BLANC 2008

Region: 63% Awatere Valley, 39% Wairau Valley

Residual Sugar: 4.1 g/L

Fruit for the 2008 Dashwood Sauvignon Blanc is a pale straw colour. This classically styled wine shows lifted melon, citrus and fresh tropical notes on the nose. These flavours follow through to the richly structured palate which has a long crisp finish.

The 2008 growing season was noteworthy for its extremes. The 2008 spring was cold and crisp, followed by a summer with warmer than average temperatures.
